The accomplishments of the 2021-2022 membership year are the result of the tremendous strength of Texas PTA and all our volunteers. Each year, we innovatively build on our past successes, learning along the way, and this year was no exception.

We began our membership growth rebound in response to a national pandemic, exceeding our goal set by the Texas PTA Board of Directors. This is something to celebrate, and it would not have been possible without our volunteers and staff! History was made as Texas PTA unveiled digital membership cards and invested in technology allowing membership rosters to be uploaded electronically, helping leaders and creating efficiencies.

Our association is only as strong as the volunteers who help us bring alive and sustain the mission of PTA, and thanks to you, we are as strong as ever! In collaboration with school administrators, medical professionals, and lawmakers, we brought much-needed attention to the mental health crisis our students are facing, spotlighting the topic in February’s Straight Talk. The insight and personal narratives that we gathered on the issue will help guide our advocacy work during the 88th Session of the Texas Legislature.

Texas PTA kept our promise to develop leaders and create new learning opportunities for both parents and students. We are absolutely thrilled with our new campus learning series called Connect which is dedicated to parent education. We are especially excited about our new leadership development certification called Full Circle Leadership and a revamp of Emerging Leaders Academy with a newly created curriculum. Through new training platforms and a facelift of existing ones, we remain committed to personal development excellence for our current and future leaders.

Students were an important emphasis this year. The virtual YES! program targeting high school juniors and seniors was highly successful, and Camp Just Imagine was pivoted as a December virtual arts experience with attendance exceeding our expectations.

As each month passed, we asked our volunteers to “step up” even more. You were always willing and ready to help. Thank you for everything you do for PTA. No doubt it has been a year of challenges, but we made these into opportunities in the true spirit of PTA. As we end 2021-2022, we can all take pride in the fact that we have remained steadfast in making every child’s potential a reality.






EXTRA CREDIT




