

Texas PTA Legislative Successes 2011

This session, Texas PTA worked to:

- Minimize cuts to funding for public education
- Pass legislation to address bullying, including cyberbullying, in schools
- Pass legislation to ban possession of K-2 or Spice, a powerful synthetic cannabis sold as incense
- Maintain class size limits in grades K-4 and maintaining the parental notification requirement when a waiver of class size limits is obtained
- Maintain School Health Advisory Councils
- Maintain Fitnessgram, although it was reduced
- Maintain the Back to School Sales Tax Holiday
