- Empower Texas PTA Board of Directors to share the benefits of PTA and PTA membership with external associations/companies:
- Collaborate with the Vice President Field Service and Field Service Committee:
- Serve on committees of the Texas PTA Board of Directors, as assigned by the Texas PTA President; and
- Serve as membership chair of Lone Star Statewide PTA.
