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SCHEDULING MEETINGS

- Make requests at end of January.
 - Get contact information for legislators' schedulers.
 - Ask to speak to scheduler or education policy person.
 - Follow up with email.
 - Bringing a large group 20+ people? Ask if staff person can reserve a meeting room for your meeting.
- Meetings' timeframe is 12:30 p.m. 5 p.m.
- Allow 20 minutes between meetings the Capitol is BIG!

MAP YOUR ROUTE

- Review map of Capitol at <u>tspb.texas.gov</u> to map your route.
- Print maps of the building.



PREPARING FOR MEETINGS

- Confirm meetings a day or two before Rally Day.
 - Let staff know how many people you are bringing.
 - Confirm you are constituents.
- Send Texas PTA's priorities one-pager to scheduler in advance.
- Review priorities on Texas PTA website:
 - Watch webinar on policy issues. (txpta.org/rally-day)
 - Review fact sheets for each priority. (txpta.org/legislative-priorities)
 - Review the Texas PTA Priorities Bill Tracker to determine what has been filed in support of each priority. (txpta.org/legislative-priorities)
- Become familiar with your legislators.
 - Review bios to determine their positions on major issues.

CONDUCTING MEETINGS

- Arrive at legislators' offices 10 minutes early.
 - Legislators may be late.
 - $\circ~$ Be ready for anything.
- Expect meetings to last 15 minutes.
- Have an agenda.
- Determine roles:
 - 1 person to handle introductions, opening statements, timekeeper
 - 2-3 people to share priorities and which priority each covers
- Turn off your phones.

TIPS FOR MAXIMUM IMPACT

- Be prepared to meet with a staffer if legislator is unavailable.
 - Make presentation as you would to legislator.
- Ask scheduler for assistance to meet with the legislator for follow up when he/she is in the district soon.
- Stick to plan/agenda and avoid getting sidetracked.
- Don't argue with legislator or staffer.
- State Texas PTA's position cordially and respectfully.

TIPS FOR MAXIMUM IMPACT

- If you cannot answer a question, DO NOT guess.
 - Tell legislator you will get the answer and get it to them. Texas PTA will assist with getting the right answer.
- Follow up with thank you note or email this is VERY important.
 - Make sure you get names of those you meet with and mention them by name in thank you note or email.
- Provide relevant meeting feedback to Texas PTA.
 - Form will be emailed to attendees following Rally Day.
