

Texas PTA Faculty Scholarship Application



Texas PTA offers up to \$500 scholarships for teachers, teachers' aides, or other faculty members planning to take college credit courses, workshops or continuing education which improves the applicant's teaching proficiency or applies to a specific education-related certification (includes middle management, administrator, counselor, etc.). These courses may include online and correspondence courses. Awarded scholarships apply to the summer, fall, and/or spring terms following the current school year.

The Texas PTA scholarship program is tangible evidence of our desire to improve the quality of education for Texas students.

Who May Apply?

- Applicant must be a teacher, teacher's aide, or other faculty member with three or more completed years of experience in Texas schools prior to application.
- Applicant must be employed in a school with a Local PTA/PTSA that has achieved Active Status by December 1.
- Applicant must be a current PTA member by December 1 at their employed campus. *Note: PTA membership is a renewable, annual membership. Current membership year begins August 1.*
- Applicant must plan to enroll no later than July 15 immediately following the notification of the award scholarship.
- Immediate family members of the Texas PTA Board of Directors or staff are not eligible to apply. Affected applicants must allow for one year to elapse before eligibility is restored.
- Must not have received a Texas PTA scholarship within the past 24 months.
- A completed electronic application must be received by November 15. Application can be found at www.txpta.org/scholarships.

Preparing Required Documents

Please submit documents as a .doc, .docx, or .pdf (preferred) format.

The online application requires:

- A resume, limited to one page, listing relevant work experience, community activities, PTA involvement, and special recognition or awards.
- Four separate responses to the following. The first three responses have a minimum of 150 and maximum of 300 word count.
 1. Describe the coursework you will undertake and how that will benefit students and families.
 2. How have you engaged families in their children's education and what impact has that had on your classroom/school?
 3. Describe how PTA has supported and enriched your classroom/school.
 4. Briefly detail how receiving this scholarship will impact your ability to pursue this coursework. (No minimum or maximum word count)

NOTE: Be prepared to provide your PTA President's name and email address.

Applicant must be a teacher, aid, or faculty member with 3 yrs of Texas school experience and a member of their campus PTA by 12/1.

Will need PTA President's email address

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Selection

Applications will be reviewed in multiple rounds, depending on number of applications received.

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Results & Disbursement

Results posted on the Texas PTA website no later than April 1.

Awardees must claim their scholarship no later than July 15.

Disbursements sent directly to institution of enrollment.

Further instructions provided on submitting required documentation for disbursement.

Failure to meet the deadline will result in forfeiture of scholarship.
